2. Visa Instruction

1. All types of visas for entry into the Kingdom of Cambodia can be applied and obtained in person at the Royal Embassy of Cambodia in Jakarta, Consular Section, at:

Business Hour : Consular Section opens from Monday to Friday, except National Holiday, with the following particulars:
- Visa Application Only : 09:00-12:00 a.m; 14:00-16:00 p.m
- Visa Pickup Only : 14:00 p.m. - 16:00 p.m.
- Processing Time : 3 working days

2. For the requirements to be met, each applicant must complete the Visa Application Form and submit it to us together with:

- A copy of applicant's flight/air-sea itinerary details. Even if applicant is entering Cambodia via ports of entry from neighboring countries.
- Three color photographs (4 X 6 cm) for one application. Taken no more than six months.
- Passport (original) with minimum 6 (six) months validity after the date of return from Cambodia
- If applicant applies for Business Visa, she must enclose a copy of support letter/invitation letter from the Company/ Institutions or Organizations in Cambodia where the applicant plans to visit.

3. Type, Fee, Validity and Condition of Visa

IV. Visa on Arrival (Tourist Visa)

Visa on Arrival can be obtained at the Visa Counter of upon arrival at the International Check Point of Cambodia. Please note that not all foreign passport holders can apply for a visa on arrival. Therefore, they should check with the nearest Royal Embassy of Cambodia for the specific visa requirements for their countries.

1. By Air: Visa on Arrival can be obtained to entry Cambodia through:

- The Phnom Penh International Airport; and
- The Siem Reap International Airport, both of which provide full services for passengers on international flights operated by many international airlines.

2. By Land: Tourists can enjoy traveling to Cambodia by land from neighboring Vietnam, Laos and Thailand.

- a. Access from Viet Nam (through nine international border checkpoints)
- Bavet International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Mook Bi (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Bavet is located in Svay Rieng Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the Mook Bi is located in Tay Ninh Province.

- Kaam Samor International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Yin Souang (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Kaam Samor is located between Kamdal and Prey Veng Provinces, and on the Vietnamese side, the Yin Souang is located in Ang Giang Province.

- Phnom Den International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Tin Benth (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Phnom Den is located in Takeo Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the Tin Benth is located in Ang Giang Province.

- Trapping Phing International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Xamet (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Trapping Phing is located in Kampong Cham Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the Xamet is located in Tay Ninh Province.

- Trapping Sra International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Bnong (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Trapping Sra is located in Kratie Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the Bnong is located in Binh Phuoc Province.

- Oydak International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Lethath (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Oydak is located in Ratanak Kiri Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the Lethath is located in Gia Lai Province.

- Banteay Chhakei International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Deth Ba (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Banteay Chhakei is located in Prey Veng Province and on the Vietnamese side, the Deth Ba is located in Dong Thap Province.

- Preak Chak International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Ho Tieng (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Preak Chak is located in Kampong Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the Ho Tieng is located in Kien Giang Province.

- Samrong International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and M Quai Tai (Vietnamese side). On the Cambodian side, the Samrong is located in Svay Rieng Province, and on the Vietnamese side, the M Quai Tai is located in Long An Province.

- a. Access from Laos: On the Cambodian side, the Trapping Kreal International border checkpoint is located in Tring Province, and on the Lao side, the Nong Nakhone International border checkpoint is located in Champasak Province.

- a. Access from Thailand (through six international border checkpoints)
- Poppet International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Ban Klang Leuk (Thai side). On the Cambodian side, the Poppet is located in Banteay Meanchey Province, and on the Thai side, the Ban Klang Leuk is located in Sakaeo Province.

- Cham Yeam International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Hat Lek (Thai side). On the Cambodian side, the Cham Yeam is located in Koh Kong Province and on the Thai side, the Hat Lek is located in Trat Province.

- O'ramach International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Chong Chom (Thai side). On the Cambodian side, the O'ramach is located in Oddar Meanchey Province, and on the Thai side, the Chong Chom is located in Sorin Province.

- Chhien International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Sangem (Thai side). On the Cambodian side, the Chhien is located in Oddar Meanchey Province, and on the Thai side, the Sangem is located in Syokiet Province.

- Prom International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Ban Palard (Thai side). On the Cambodian side, the Prom is located in Pailin Province, and on the Thai side, the Ban Palard is located in Chanthaburi Province.

- Dong International border checkpoint (Cambodian side) and Ban Lem (Thai side). On the Cambodian side, the Dong is located in Battambang Province, and on the Thai side, the Ban Lem is located in Chanthaburi Province.

3. By Water: Cambodia can be reached by boat/air from neighboring countries and the world. The Sihanouk International Seaport and the Phnom Penh International Port are two main gateways to Cambodia. Visas upon arrival are available only at the Phnom Penh International Port, but they are not available at the Sihanouk International Seaport.

V. E-Visa or Electronic Visa

To promote tourism and investment in Cambodia, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation has launched e-visa or electronic visa. Travelers who wish to visit Cambodia can apply visa online with credit card payment direct to the Ministry's website.
